

## **2020 Election Dates**

- **9/4/20 Absentee Ballot Applications:** Absentee ballot applications are available in the Circuit Clerk's Office for the November 3, 2020 General Election. Absentee ballots will not be available at this time. (Miss. Code Ann. section 23-15-625)
- **9/21/20 Absentee Ballots Available:** Earliest day to vote by an absentee ballot in the Circuit Clerk's Office. (Miss. Code Ann. section 23-15-715)
- 9/24/20 Absentee Ballot Deadline for Permanently Disabled Voters: Circuit Clerks' Offices mail absentee ballots to voters on the permanently disabled list. (Miss. Code Ann. section 23-15-629(4))
- **9/28/20 -10/2/20 Voter Registration:** Circuit Clerks' Offices *may* remain open from 8:00 am until 7:00 pm, including the noon hour. (Miss. Code Ann section 23-15-37)
- **10/3/20 Voter Registration:** Circuit Clerks' Offices *must* remain open from 8:00 am until 12:00 pm for voter registration. (Miss. Code Ann section 23-15-37)
- **10/5/20 General Election Voter Registration Deadline:** Applicants who register in person in the Circuit Clerk's Office today and those who mail registration applications postmarked no later than today are eligible to vote in the General Election. (Miss. Code Ann. section 23-15-47)
- **10/24/20 Absentee Voting:** Circuit Clerk's Office *must* be open from 8:00 am until 12:00 pm for absentee in-person voting. (Miss Code Ann. section 23-15-653)
- 10/31/20 In-Person Absentee Voting Deadline, 5:00 pm: Absentee ballots cast in person must be cast in the Circuit Clerk's Office by 5:00 pm this year. (Miss. Code Ann. section 23-15-637)
- 11/3/20 General Election: Polls will be open from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. (Miss. Code Ann. section 23-15-541)
- 11/3/20 Absentee Ballot Postmark Deadline: Absentee ballots received by mail must be postmarked on or before the date of the election. (Miss Code Ann section 23-15-637)
- 11/10/20 Absentee Ballot Receipt Deadline: Absentee ballots received by mail must be received by the Circuit Clerk. (Miss. Code Ann section 23-15-637)
- 11/10/20 Voter ID Affidavit Ballot Deadline, 5:00 pm: Last day voters who cast an affidavit ballot by reason of voter photo ID may present an acceptable form of photo ID or complete an affidavit of religious objection in the Circuit Clerks' Offices. (Miss Const 1890 section 249-A)
